CHECK: all equipment that has been in contact with water, remove all plant material at the site.

CLEAN: your with 5% gear detergent solution between waterways. Pay Special Attention to: Rods, lines. reels. flies. nets. Jet boats grate/unit, outboard motors and is bilge pumps.
