Smoking

Strictly **no smoking inside any of the campground buildings** - cabins, toilet block, kitchens, laundry and admin building block

Open Fires/Fireworks

Open fires are prohibited in the campground, reserve and beach. The setting off of fireworks is prohibited at the Campground, reserve and beach.

Speed Limit – please drive slowly and look out for children. Maximum speed is 15km.

Children

Your children are your responsibility. Please supervise them at all times – especially around hazardous areas such as the toilet block, kitchen, playground and the river.

No recreational dirt/trail bikes, Motorbikes, 3 & 4 wheelers, side by

sides to be ridden in or around the campground including the reserve & bridge

Office/Shop

If the office/shop is unattended please ring the bell and/or check the notice board for messages/advice

Arrival/Departure from the Camp

Arrival is any time after 2pm. Departure time is by 11.am unless alternative arrangements have been made with the Camp manager. Please return any keys to the office prior to departure.

Accounts

Accounts are payable on arrival. A refund for early departure will only be made in exceptional circumstances.

Caravans and campervans

Please ensure that you camp within your own site. Must be parked with **towbars facing out** – this is a safety factor in case of emergency. All caravans and campervans must have an electrical Warrant of Fitness and comply with LPG standard (NZS 5428:1996). All caravans and campervans must have their own wastewater container.

Powered sites

Please ensure that you camp within your own site. Power can only be connected to power through an approved isolating transformer or RCD safety switch

Parking

There is a maximum of 2 cars per site.

Please park within or as close as possible to the boundary of your site. Please **do no** park on vacant sites. Please comply with all campground regulations. campers/caravans/tents must be 1.5 metres from your site boundary and 3m between caravans, tents or campervans/buildings.

Kitchens

Freezers and Refrigerators are provided in both kitchens. Please name your food and remove on your departure. **Please don't put bait in the food fridge.** Please leave the facilities clean after use.

Toilet Block – Campers ONLY Please be respectful and leave these

facilities clean after use. To avoid blocking drains, please wash sand/grass off using the outside showers – **before** using the showers. Children under 7yrs **must** be supervised in the ablution block. **Token operated showers** – tokens available for purchase from the office. Please return any unused tokens for refund.

Laundry

Coin/token operated washing machines and a drier are available \$4.00 each load. Coins/tokens and soap powder are available from the office.

Cleaning of fish

No cleaning of fish at the camping ground/kitchens. There is a fish cleaning facility by the Reserve toilet block below the camping grounds. No bait to be put in the food fridges.

Dump station is located alongside the

laundry block. Camp **soakhole** is in front of cabin area.

Rubbish & Recycling

Please place your bottles in the Glass Recycling Unit located beside the Rubbish cage at the Camp entrance or in the recycling bin by the camp kitchen. General rubbish in bins provided around the campground.

Emergencies

Familiarise yourself with the evacuation plan which is located in the kitchens, cabins, laundry. The muster point is clearly marked at the bottom of the hill to the left of the Rubbish / Recycling building. All emergencies please contact Camp Managers.

A First Aid kit is held at the office. Report all accidents to the Camp Manager. **Defibrillator** Located outside the Camp office

Lost property

Will be held at the office for 2 weeks and then donated to charity.

Tidiness

Please keep your site tidy.

Visitors

Visitors to your site are your responsibility and must leave the camping ground by 9pm. They must park in allocated parking areas or as close to your site as possible without obstructing other camp sites or blocking the road.
