

Behaviour

Please respect others. Any person behaving in an objectionable manner may be requested to leave the Camping Ground at the discretion of the Camp Managers.

Noise

Please keep the noise down after 11pm. (An exception will be made, of course, on New Year's Eve.) No radios or other broadcasting devices (TVs, DVDs, CDs, etc.) between 11pm and 7am.

Smoking

Strictly no smoking in the toilet block, showers, or other communal areas. All buildings are to be kept smoke free.

Alcohol and drugs

Within the Camping Ground, restrict your drinking of alcohol to your own campsite. Excessive drinking and noisy parties are forbidden. The presence or use of illegal drugs will not be tolerated - police will be called. Outside the Camping Ground, please note that an alcohol and drug ban applies to the Reserve.

Open fires

Open fires are prohibited.

Fireworks

The setting off of fireworks is prohibited at the Camping Ground.

Arrival and departure

On arrival, please check in at the Office to be allocated a site. Once you have completed your stay, departure time is 11am unless alternative arrangements have been made with a Camp Manager.

Accounts

The account balance, if not paid before, is payable on arrival. A refund for early departure will only be made in exceptional circumstances.

Office hours

These, in normal circumstances, are from 9am to 8pm.

Shop

The Shop – like the Office, and particularly over weekends and when it is sunny – is open from 9am till 8pm. Go to the Office for service. Items for sale may include groceries, milk, pies, hot chips, drinks, ice blocks, and ice.

Emergencies

Familiarise yourself with the Evacuation Plan for the Camping Ground. It is on the whiteboard outside the main kitchen, by the Office. Know where the Assembly Area is. In case of an emergency, listen for announcements by loud hailer from the Office. If possible and appropriate, go to the Office for advice.

First aid

A First Aid Kit is located at the Office. Report all accidents to a Camp Manager as soon as possible.

Notices

Check the whiteboard on the outside wall of the main kitchen, by the Office, for notices.

Kitchens, refrigerators and freezers

Refrigerators and freezers are provided in the kitchens alongside the Office. If you wish to use them, please name all your food and remove it on departure.

Ablution block

To avoid blocking of drains, please wash sand off – using the outside showers – before using the coin-operated hot showers. Children under 7 years of age must be supervised.

Laundry

Coin-operated washing machines and dryers are available. Washing powder and \$2 coins are available at the Office.

Lost property

Will be held at the Office and donated to charity after a three-month period.

Speed limit

The Camping Ground speed limit is 15kph.

Site requirements

There is a maximum of two cars per site. To comply with Camping Ground Regulations please ensure your tent, caravan or campervan is 1.5 metres from your site boundary and 3 metres between tents, caravans, campervans or buildings.

Tents

Tents can only be connected through an approved isolating transformer or RCD safety switch

Caravans and campervans

Caravans must be parked with tow bars facing out – this is a safety factor, in case of emergency. Caravans and campervans must have an electrical warrant of fitness and comply with LPG Standard (NZS 5428:1996). All campervans and caravans must have their own wastewater container.

Children

Your children are your responsibility. Please supervise them at all times – and especially around hazardous areas such as the facilities block, kitchen, playground, and the river.

Visitors

Visitors to your site are your responsibility and must leave the Camping Ground by 10pm.

Dogs

No dogs are allowed. This is a South Taranaki District Council by-law.

Tidiness

Please keep your site tidy. Provide your own waste container. Leave all facilities clean after use – sinks, benches, stoves, washing machines, the BBQ. Ensure your food waste is wrapped before putting it in the Camping Ground bins. All food waste must be wrapped and placed in the appropriate rubbish bins.

Cleaning of Fish

No cleaning of fish at the Camping Ground. If needed, use the facility by the toilets below the Camping Ground, alongside the river.
